



Autocamping Česká brána - operating rules

- 1. Entry to the campsite is only permitted after registration at the reception. Guests check in at the reception, where they are registered after presenting their personal documents and at the same time pay for their stay at the campsite. Here they will receive a sign on which the length of their paid stay is indicated. The sign is usually placed on a tent, caravan, or other accommodation facility.**
- 2. A friendly and considerate behaviour as well as ensuring cleanliness and order are of course the duty of all camping users.**
- 3. The instructions of the receptionist must be followed. The receptionist will direct you to the space and other accommodation. The car is usually parked next to the tent or caravan.**
- 4. Dogs of all sizes must be kept on a leash at all times.**
- 5. Surrounding your camping space with ditches and fences is prohibited. It is important to ensure that no one is endangered or bothered by tent pegs, tent cords and other tent accessories.**
- 6. Garbage of all kinds belongs exclusively to the containers located in the campsite. Plastic bottles must be stepped on.**
- 7. Open fires are strictly prohibited.**
- 8. At the campsite, the night's quiet begins at 10 p.m. and lasts until 7 a.m. No vehicle is allowed to enter or leave the camp during this time. Absolute calm must be maintained. The gate will be closed from 11 p.m.**
- 9. Excessive noise is also not permitted during the day. All noise harassment, especially from musical instruments, radios, music box, noise from motor vehicles, etc. are prohibited.**
- 10. Riding bicycles, mopeds, playing ball in places where there is accommodation is considered harassment and it is necessary to move to places reserved for this.**
- 11. Parking on the road within the campsite is prohibited.**
- 12. Driving motor vehicles is permitted only on arrival and departure, to the place of your accommodation facility. It is necessary to drive very slow in the campsite.**
- 13. The campsite is used exclusively for relaxation. The performance of commercial and craft activities by visitors is prohibited.**
- 14. The receptionist, administrator or security guard is entitled to refuse to accept people or to expel them from the campsite in the interest of order in the campsite and in the interest of other guests.**
